

## The Overall Foundational Importance of Genesis to the Bible is Regularly Expounded Upon at NBBS

### *Emphasis Upon Genesis at NBBS*

**Old Testament Survey** – Several charts and detailed notes are given on Genesis relating to creation, Adam, the Flood, the Tower of Babel, and Israel.

**Pentateuch I (Genesis)** – A chapter-by-chapter study of Genesis. At times, largely ascension-by-sentence as in the study of Genesis 1-11, and later key portions (altars, 4 of the 7 O/T covenants, the emergence Israel, etc.).

**Biblical Structure** – Genesis is shown to be foundational in numerous ways to the Biblical presentation of truth from Exodus to Revelation (e.g., *The 12 Major Events of the O/T, the first five are in Genesis 1-11*).

**World History Overview** – Begins with an in-depth focus on Genesis 1-11 and the absolute relevance of creation, the fall of all mankind, the flood, the tower of Babel event, and what the rise of Israel means to history.

**Creation Science** – Numerous DVDs are viewed with accompanying notes and charts on the nature, and relevance of the Creation & the Flood today.

**Apologetics and Ethics** – How Genesis 1:1 refutes numerous “isms” commonly found in today’s world, the significant evidence of the Genesis record of origins, and the relevance of God’s created order to ethics is shown. The veracity of the Genesis record via archaeology, is pointed out.

**Bible Doctrine I Overview** – It is shown how every attribute of God is set-off in Genesis 1:1. Other passages from Genesis are cited that support such.

**Family** – It is shown how Adam and Eve – before and after the fall – in Genesis 1-3, exemplify Biblical principles on the marriage. Marriages of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob are included in the study.

**Bible Doctrine V (Christology)** – Christ is shown to be the primary person of the Godhead active in Creation. It is also pointed out how the miracles He performed during the days of the Gospels tie into the Genesis account of creation, and how they undergird the fact of His deity. Also, the many foreshadowings of Christ in Genesis through various means are shown (persons, animals, objects, events, and places, etc.).

**Romans** – How Paul’s presentation in Romans 1:18-32 is fundamentally tied into Creation and the Flood is expounded. The role that Adam and Eve, and Abraham’s encounters with God, played in God’s plan of salvation.

**Personal Evangelism** – Adam’s headship (Rom. 5:12-14, 19, I Cor. 15:21-22, 45), his fall into sin, and God’s plan of the Gospel from the outset is shown.

Our students are urged to take advantage of the longstanding Dallas based **Institute of Creation Research’s**<sup>1</sup> resources (publications, videos, and newly built museum).

Also, to make use of various resources of the **Answers in Genesis** ministry via the internet, and visit **AIG’s Creation Museum & full-size Ark in Kentucky** in the summer.

**Above all**, the students regularly are able to attend lectures at the nearby **Creation Evidence Museum** in Glen Rose, Texas, founded and directed by Dr. Carl Baugh. They are also able to participate in excavations at a site assigned to NBBS by Dr. Baugh of CEM.


## Alumni News!

## Seeing the Relevance of Noah's Flood!

Annually now, for four years, NBBS students, in conjunction with Dr. Carl Baugh (director of the Creation Evidence Museum), have excavated dinosaur tracks at the Paluxy River outside of Glen Rose, Texas. **The students readily express how much the venture undergirds their study of Noah's flood.** Dr. Baugh, is on hand with lectures, directing on how to excavate, and answering related questions to Creation and the Noah's Flood event from the students. This March, four days were spent on the excavation site dedicated to NBBS by CEM. **A very surprising item was uncovered by one of the students, on the last day of the dig!** See the picture below, at the bottom.



This is how the 250-foot long site looked Monday before it was further excavated by some 30 students. Different levels were worked, at times by three separate teams, in assigned sections.

Friday yielded dinosaur tracks and a surprise find!



To the left, is apparently a section of a rib cage bone from an *Acrocanthosaurus*! A 36" x 18" section of the rock, in which it is embedded, was removed for further analyzation of the bone.
