One of our newest IBFI missionaries, 2021 NBBS graduate **Tyler Yates**, is well under way in his deputation. He has made three trips to his ultimate place of service, the Yucatan Peninsula, in

Mexico, since late last year.

The Yucatán Peninsula was the central location of the Maya Civilization. A large percentage of the population is Mayan descendants of the original civilization that stretched from the peninsula into the Mexican State of Chiapas, Guatemala, Belize and parts of El Salvador and Honduras. The largest proportion of inhabitants though are Mexican people whose Spanish descent bloodline is mixed with that of the indigenous population.

Tyler Yates was a very good student at the Norris Bible Baptist Seminary. He was very teachable and well-liked by the student body. During his time in seminary he was mentored by his pastor, Javier Garza, serving primarily as the youth director, while also serving under him in various other capacities.
